Step 1

Sit for the "Placement Test" at ELS Language Centres (UPM branch) to determine your English proficiency and the CIEP level that you will enter. **The Placement Test fee is RM159.00** and is to be paid at ELS Language Centres (UPM branch).

If you agree to continue with the CIEP, proceed to Step 2.

Step 2

Proceed to make the payment for the CIEP(as listed below) to UPM Education & Training Sdn Bhd's (UPM-ET) account at CIMB Bank (refer to page #2 for the bank details). Then, complete and return the application form for Non-Graduating Programme (NG) to the School of Graduate Studies (SGS).

Step 3

Present the original CIMB receipt of the CIEP payment to ELS Language Centres (UPM branch) in order to start classes. Students are also required to pay other compulsory fees (NG programme, health insurance, student card and medical check-up) to the relevant UPM departments.

Step 4

Bring the documents below to **International Centre**, **Visa & Pass Division** for the processing of the student pass/visa and pay the visa processing fees:

Note:

A "Provisional Admission" status is awarded to those who pass CIEP Level 107. Students will then be permitted to register for academic courses in UPM. However, in order to fulfill the UPM's English Proficiency Requirement, students are still required to complete two (2) levels of CIEP (Level 108 and 109) within ONE (1) year, from the start of the CIEP.
